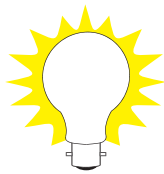

## COMPLETE LAWN CARE CORNER

### TURF TIPS/SUMMER 2004

Surface feeding insects, lawn disease and preventive grub control are what you should be thinking about now. Identifying insect or disease damage can be tricky and is a lot more than just spots in the lawn so it's probably best to contact a professional. Lawn diseases that we get this time of year are red thread and dollar spot. These diseases are present as a result of the grass plants weakened state and will be remedied with a light fertilization, mowing the lawn at 3-3 1/2 inches and watering regularly, deeply and during morning hours (at least 40 minutes per section once or twice a week). If you've had grub damage in the past you may want to consider a preventive application for grubs. June is the month for this application and make sure you water it in.
